### How do you get to the Faculty by bus ?

You must take bus n°10 (C.H Le Gendre)

Stop : Vanteaux (Once you are off the bus, follow the road on the right and you will arrive at the Faculty).

## SERVICE RELATIONS INTERNATIONALES

Our office is located within the «Faculté des Lettres et des Sciences Humaines» (Faculty of Arts and Humanities). It is situated on the ground floor, door C012.

We can help you with :

- Choosing courses and enrolling in classes

If you arrive at **Limoges Airport** (10km from the city centre), know that there is no bus to the city centre. Taxi companies however can get you from the airport to the city centre for approximately 20€ (Limoges Taxi : +33 555 38 38 38).

If you arrive at Limoges **Train Station**, there is a bus stop nearby (Gare des Bénédictins).

# Housing

The «Bureau d'Accueil International» can help you find accommodation in Limoges :

- All exchange students can apply for a pre-booked en-suite bedroom or studio.
- In order to apply for student housing you must fill in the [form](#).
- This reservation will be confirmed once the deposit (360€ for studios, 240€ for bedrooms) has been paid. Pay attention to the deadline. This deposit will be given back to you when you leave.

## HALLS OF RESIDENCE

The monthly rent for an **en-suite bedroom** with fridge, varies between 228-245€ (rent includes utilities such as electricity, water and heating). The only communal area is the kitchen which is equipped with hotplates, a microwave and a small oven.

The monthly rent for a **studio**, varies between 362-400€ (utilities such as electricity, water and heating are not included in the rent). Studios offer more space, have their own bathroom and kitchenette (microwave not included).

Certain residences also give access to many services and facilities such as : a self-service laundromat, a TV room and snack machines.



The main halls are :

**Résidence Camille-Guérin** (best location for students attending FLSH) : en-suite bedrooms and studios on the Faculty of Arts and Humanities campus. It is within a 5 minute walk from the faculty, the library, the university restaurant and the VANTEAUX bus stop (direct bus line n°10 to city centre).

**Résidence La Borie** : en-suite bedrooms and studios on the Faculty of Sciences campus. It is approximately 15-20 minutes away from the Faculty of Arts and Humanities (bus n°14 : stop FACULTÉ).

**Résidence Saint Martial** (located in the city centre): en-suite bedrooms and studios in the town centre. It is approximately 15-20 minutes away from the Faculty of Arts and Humanities (bus n°10 : stop PLACE JOURDAN).

## TIPS

- How to get internet in the residence halls?  
When you arrive, go to the reception, they will open up an internet subscription for you and an access code. You must bring an ethernet cable with as it is not provided. There is no WiFi in the halls.
- Kitchenware and pans are **not** provided, but know that the international relations office has a small stock of stuff left by previous students that you can borrow.
- In order to retrieve your keys, it is preferable that you arrive during the reception's opening hours Monday to Friday from **9h-12h** and from **14h-17h** (**avoid the week-end**) and you must have have a **proof of housing insurance** (the «Bureau d'Accueil International» can help you with this formality).

## ON CAMPUS LIBRARIES

### University library :

Open weekdays from 8am to 7:30pm.

The student library is open to all students.

You are free to consult and borrow books, textbooks, newspapers and films as long as you can show proof of enrolment (student ID).

The library also has many computers connected to the internet and printers at your service.

### Research/Study libraries :

## FOOD AND SERVICES

### University restaurant

Situated on the FLSH campus, Restaurant THERESE MENOT, opens Monday to Friday, from 11:30am to 1:30pm is situated on the FLSH campus. It is a brand new restaurant with a large inside and outside cafeteria.

A student dish of the day set menu costs 3.25€, otherwise there is also a grilled food and vegetarian stall, a pizza and pasta stall and a café area.

### Crous «Cafet»

Located within the faculty entry hall, this cafeteria provides students with a varied supply of sandwiches, salads, paninis, wraps, croque-monsieurs, savoury pies, chips, a large variety of desserts, pastries, American cakes, tea coffee and sodas.

Student menus range from 3.25-4€.

Open Monday to Friday, from 8am to 3:30pm.

### «Coop Cafet»

A cafeteria created and run by students for students of the faculty.

It provides fair-trade and organic products such as coffee and tea, and it is a fun place to hang out between classes.

## ON CAMPUS HEALTH SERVICE

The «Maison Médicale» of the University is at your service.

Situated on the FLSH campus you can make appointments (free of charge) with health professionals.
